

## Job Hazard Form

This form highlights hazards related to the role that could pose a risk to the post holder.

Role Title: Assistant Caretaker

### Manual Handling

This role requires hazardous manual handling operations. For example, regular moving of objects.

These manual handling operations are required on a daily basis.

The weights involved in these manual handling operations are approx. 6-20kg

### Job Characteristics

This role involves working with children and young people of up to age 11 years old.

This role involves early morning working and may involve occasional evening work up to 6pm.

### Work Environment

This role is carried out in an environment which involves occasional working at height.

This role could involve occasional working in a room on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the building. Access to this floor is by stairs only.

### Personal Protective Equipment

Given the nature of this role, the post holder is required to wear personal protective equipment to be worn on their head/face/eyes/body/arms/legs/feet/hands as appropriate. This will be provided by the school.

### COSHH (Control of Substances Hazardous to Health)

#### Biological Hazards

It is possible that postholder may come into routine or regular contact with people with infections e.g. human bodily fluid through soil or waste.

Applicants should be aware that where roles are exposed to hazardous risks, risk assessments are undertaken and control measures are put into place where possible.
